### **2021 Year 1 Student Charges Information**

Kingsley Park Primary School spends considerable time selecting the most appropriate items and services to meet the needs of our students. Some items are distributed to students at the beginning of the year and some are kept in storage for use throughout the year. Where possible, classroom based curriculum resources are purchased in bulk to ensure costings are kept to a minimum for parents.

In line with the Department of Education and Training Guidelines, and our Parent Payment Policy, parents are asked to pay for essential educational items. **Essential educational items** are those items or services that are essential to support the course of instruction in the standard curriculum program that parents or guardians are required to pay the school to provide or may provide themselves, if applicable.

### **Definition of Charges**

**Consumable Materials** is a contribution to our Science, Art and Auslan programs than run throughout the school. These programs encourage students to express themselves in different ways outside of the standard classroom and within our 8 Key Learning Areas. The resources will be used for the Science, Art and Auslan programs that are run in classrooms and in specialist classes. For example, paint and craft materials including but not limited to dots, glitter, paints and cardboard.

**Online Subscriptions** is the provision of software and Applications that underpins all subject areas. This includes Mathletics/Mathseeds, Reading Eggs and Essential Assessment.

**Book Packs** are an important part of a student's learning. Listed over are items included on the booklists. We have sourced the most competitive prices and they will be delivered directly to the school ready for the start of Term 1. You are not required to collect the packs, as they will be distributed directly to your child's classroom. Each child will receive their pack and tick off the list of items received. Their additional items needed throughout the year will be placed in a named zip lock bag o be accessed as needed throughout the year. Parents may purchase some requirements of the booklist themselves but must ensure accuracy of the items: eg line size, page numbers, grid sizes etc. As we purchase classroom consumables in bulk it is difficult to purchase smaller quantities themselves eg half a packed of A4 paper, coloured card, ¼ packet of kinder circles.

### **Voluntary Financial Contributions**

Parents may be asked to make a donation to the school for general or specific purposes. Our voluntary contributions will be used for library books, take home books and also the maintenance of our facilities. Kingsley Park families are encouraged to make a voluntary contribution to assist us to keep our school in its peak condition. Kingsley Park proudly has a strong Technology focus in all year levels with the Prep – Year 2's having the Classroom iPad program, and Years 3-6 having the individual iPad program. All programs require maintenance and support and any contributions towards our programs are greatly appreciated.
